Call to Order

Chair T. Hudrlik (MN) called the meeting to order at 11:04 am ET. Five voting members were present, a quorum was established.

Approval of Agenda and Minutes

A motion by Commissioner D. Cady (NH) to approve the meeting’s agenda was adopted.

The approval of January meeting’s minutes was deferred to the next meeting.

Discussion

RNR Chapter 5 rule recommendations: At the last meeting, the committee reviewed Chapter 5 amendments and discussed DCA K. O’Leary’s recommended changes to Rule 5.102. The Executive Committee met and adopted the proposal package, including the recommended changes from Massachusetts.

The committee reviewed rule proposal 5.102-1 and agreed to reinstate a timeframe for reporting violations once the violation framework has been applied. The committee also agreed to seek feedback from the RNR pilot states before moving forward.

[Current 4.109 with revised language]
5.102-1: Reporting Violations Requiring Retaking

1. A receiving state shall notify the sending state of behavior requiring retaking as determined under Rule 5.102 *Evaluating Violations and Stability for Retaking Decisions* by submitting a violation report **within 30 calendar days.**

A motion by Commissioner D. Cady (NH) to recommend adding a 30-calendar day timeframe to Rule 5.102-1(1) was adopted.

The committee had no other changes to the proposal package.

A motion by Commissioner J. Mosly (MO) to recommend the RNR Chapter 5 Rule Proposal package for approval was adopted.

The Committee set the rule proposal comment period from April 23 to June 5, 2026.

The Committee scheduled the Rules Committee Town Hall for June 1, 2026, at 2:00 p.m. ET, to accommodate participants from western states.

The Committee will incorporate feedback from both the comment period and the Town Hall into the proposal package this summer before posting the final version for Commission review.

The Public Hearing will be held virtually in August 2026.

M. Spring informed the Committee that the National Office is adding titles to the rule references within rules document. As this is an editorial change, no formal action is required from the committee.

Old/New Business

The committee tabled its discussion on the use of 'graduated sanctions' in rule language until its next meeting.
